

EU Summer Intensive Study

The **EU Summer Intensive Study** begins on **22-May-2012 (Tuesday)**. It will include a range of interesting **Books, Movies** and **Video Lectures**. The purpose of this study is to build a strong foundation on the Christian doctrine and seek to unlearn many of the traditional teachings of the churches, and look afresh at the theological implications of the Bible.
