Some motifs cross span most every topic in the university

Beauty

Visual:

macro representations – cosmology – Museum of Natural History
micro representations – microscope

Aural:

--sounds of speech, song

--sounds of deep ocean

--sounds of Saturn

--sounds of rhyme in poetry

Cognitive: --mathematics, logic --poetry, prose

Awe/Wonder

Order

Discovering it – creating it – manipulating it – critiquing it – imagining it

Example: Halliday writings on Transnational Legal Orders Cf. also Political order -- Moral order -- Physiological order of the human body

Some motifs have an affinity with social sciences, law, and helping professions

Oppression – observing it – countering it

Studies in political science, international relations, international law, sociology

Power - the perversions of sin - by rulers, by seductresses, by religious leaders

Studies in sociology, political science

Justice – redeeming power – revealing injustice – favoritism for rich, for whites, for men – corruption

Studies in law, political philosophy, sociolegal scholarship – amplifying what is justice – how it is experienced – what institutions do and do not administer justice

Freedom - Cf. Roosevelt's 4 freedoms in debates over rights in China

Freedoms from . . . want, repression, persecution . . . Freedoms for . . . good works, exercise of dignity . . .

Forgiveness

Studies in positive psychology

Equality

So many research agendas touch it explicitly, implicitly – a radical biblical theme – often cited by China activists

Central to scholarship in economics, sociology

Links to studies of altruism in anthropology, psychology
