# Here are 3 practical approaches to apply the intersection of biblical themes x scholarly issues.

- 1. **Personal** for ourselves how we think about our own interests, research topics, specialization
- 2. **Interactional** in conversations how we ask questions of others how we respond to others in conversations
- 3. **Organizational** for our Christian programs on campus

E.g. organize a series on PUBLIC HEALTH
